FIRST PENANCE, FIRST EUCHARIST, CONFIRMATION: Though immediate preparation is given to children before receiving these sacraments, it is expected that children receive a Christian education within their family life, through formal religious education classes, and by attending Sunday worship services.

Reflecting on God's Word

This week all three scripture readings illustrate the reward system that God offers for those who make worthy sacrifices. Unlike the sacrifices of overwork, these sacrifices bring eternal rewards. The story of Elisha and the helpful woman exemplifies the rewards of generosity. She acts not out of self-interest, but out of respect for God's servant, the prophet Elisha. Her generosity is rewarded with new life in her womb, a son to care for her in her old age. Paul tells us that all who die to sin shall live with Christ "in newness of life" (Romans 6:4). Finally, Jesus says that "whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. . . and whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones" will be rewarded (Matthew 10:39, 42). Sacrifice is at the heart of Christian discipleship, but then, so is the Resurrection.
