BAPTISMS: Every third Sunday of the month at 12:00. Parents are expected to attend Pre-Baptismal Classes. Arrangements to be made at the Parish Office. **Only practicing Catholics may act as Godparents.**

MARRIAGES: Specific time is set for the celebration of marriage on Saturdays. The common Policy for all the Dioceses of New Jersey requires a period of preparation for the sacrament of Marriage, which includes sessions with the parish priest and attendance at either the Pre-Cana conferences or the Engaged Encounter Weekend. Therefore, arrangements are to be made at least one year in advance and before any social plans are finalized.

FIRST PENANCE, FIRST EUCHARIST, CONFIRMATION:

Though immediate preparation is given to children before receiving these sacraments, it is expected that children receive a Christian education within their family life, through formal religious education classes, and by attending Sunday worship services.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK: Arrangements for Communion Calls to the sick at home may be made by calling the Parish Office.

PARISH REGISTRATION: Our parish welcomes new members to our faith community. Catholic persons new to our area must complete a registration form and be interviewed by the pastor. Please call or stop by the Parish office to complete a registration form. We should also be notified if your address has changed or if you are leaving the parish..

First Reading - Filled with the Holy Spirit, the apostles begin to speak in tongues.

Second Reading - In one Spirit we are baptized into one body.

Gospel - Jesus Christ appears to the disciples and sends them on their mission.

Pentecost Sunday

"Suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a violent wind. . . it filled the whole house. . . And there appeared to them parted tongues as of fire, which settled upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit".

On Christmas we celebrate the birthday of Christ in His Physical Body. Today is the birthday of the Church, of all those who have been reborn into His Mystical Body.

How did the first Christians prepare? They were all "in prayer"; and they were "all of one mind," under the leadership of Peter, making ready to tell "men from every nation under heaven. . . of the wonderful works of God". Yes, prayer and action are the marks of the true Christian.

In the Offertory we ask the Holy Spirit to "confirm" the graces "wrought in us" when we were baptized and confirmed. We pray also "to relish" things of the Spirit and to benefit by "His consolation" in the struggle of Church and soul against "the prince of the world".

Catholic Communication Campaign.

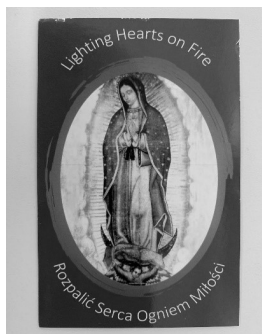

UPDATE FROM BISHOP CHECCHIO

LITURGICAL CELEBRATIONS - The faithful participating in Mass are expected to wear masks in accord with CDC guidelines for indoor gatherings and are to be encouraged to practice social distancing. At the discretion of pastors, all pews may be opened for seating. A section of pews should be designated for those who would prefer to keep a greater distance. Again, at the pastor's discretion, altar servers, lectors, ushers, greeters and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion can be returned to service. Ushers may take up the offertory collection at the proper time and the procession to present the gifts of bread and wine may be resumed. The distribution of Holy Communion should be returned to its proper place within the Communion Rite. Parishes must be vigilant about cleaning commonly touched surfaces. Effective today, the gathering for indoors will be 50% or a maximum of 250 people. Effective May 19, 2021, indoor religious services and celebrations may be held at 100% of the room's capacity with appropriate social distancing.
