MARRIAGES: Specific time is set for the celebration of marriage on Saturdays. The common Policy for all the Dioceses of New Jersey requires a period of preparation for the sacrament of Marriage, which includes sessions with the parish priest and attendance at either the Pre-Cana conferences or the Engaged Encounter Weekend. Therefore, arrangements are to be made at least one year in advance and before any social plans are finalized.

FIRST PENANCE, FIRST EUCHARIST, CONFIRMATION:

Though immediate preparation is given to children before receiving these sacraments, it is expected that children receive a Christian education within their family life, through formal religious education classes, and by attending Sunday worship services.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK: Arrangements for Communion Calls to the sick at home may be made by calling the Parish Office.

PARISH REGISTRATION: Our parish welcomes new members to our faith community. Catholic persons new to our area must complete a registration form and be interviewed by the pastor. St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross

A brilliant philosopher who stopped believing in God
when she was 14, Edith Stein was so captivated by reading
the autobiography of Teresa of Avila that she began a
spiritual journey that led to her baptism in 1922. Twelve
years later she imitated Saint Teresa by becoming a Car-
melite, taking the name Teresa Benedicta of the Cross.
Born into a prominent Jewish family in Breslau, Germa-
ny—now Wroclaw, Poland—Edith abandoned Judaism
in her teens. As a student at the University of Göttingen,
Edith earned a doctorate in philosophy in 1916. She con-
tinued as a university teacher until 1922, when she moved
to a Dominican school as lecturer at the Educational Insti-
tute of Munich ended under pressure from the Nazis.
After living for four years in the Cologne Carmel, Sister
Teresa Benedicta moved to the Carmelite monastery in
Echt, Netherlands, in 1938. The Nazis occupied that
country in 1940. In retaliation for being denounced by the
Dutch bishops, the Nazis arrested all Dutch Jews who had
become Christians. Teresa Benedicta and her sister Rosa,
also a Catholic, died in a gas chamber in Auschwitz on
August 9, 1942.

Pope John Paul II beatified Teresa Benedicta of the Cross
in 1987 and canonized her 12 years later.
