THE GIFT OF FAITH

Faith is a gift. When the disciples asked Jesus to increase their faith, they were going to the source of that faith with their request. God is the giver of all good gifts, including faith. When we put our faith in Christ, we believe that God is with us, even though we cannot physically see God. Or can we? If we are attentive, we see the evidence of God's presence in the love of family and friends, care poured out in service of our neighbors, the living beauty of creation. This is not blind faith, but rather is the result of seeing with the eyes of faith. Followers of Jesus look beyond what is apparent to see what is possible with the power and presence of the Holy Spirit within and among us.

WHY WE DEDICATE THE MONTH OF OCTOBER TO THE HOLY ROSARY

The Catholic League entered into battle against the Ottoman Empire in 1571, to protect Italy from invasion. The Turks were on a warpath to overthrow all of Europe. They had conquered the Middle East and Mediterranean islands of Cyrus and Crete. Italy was next.

As the impending battle loomed, Pope Pius V called on religious communities throughout Europe to join him in praying the rosary to defeat the Islamic threat. Heading into battle, every man in the forces carried a rosary. Miraculously, the Catholic League returned victorious after a battle known as the Battle of Lepanto. In thanksgiving for Mary's intercession and protection, Pope Pius V declared the day — October 7 — as a feast day for Our Lady of the Rosary. After the feast day was established, the entire month of October was dedicated to the rosary in 1884 by Pope Leo XIII
